Common Antimicrobial Uses Around the House

- **Disinfectants & Sanitizers:** Disinfecting and sanitizing products, like sprays and wipes, help kill germs and other microbes on surfaces, reducing the spread of disease.
- **Material Preservatives:** Household products, such as paints, laundry detergents, and cleaning products, often contain antimicrobial preservatives to help prevent spoilage and make products last longer.
- **Textile Preservatives:** Curtains, bedding, shower curtains, and other textiles can be treated with antimicrobials to help prevent the growth of bacteria, mold, and mildew.
- **Wood Treatment:** Wood is often treated with antimicrobial preservatives to help protect wooden decks, furniture, and fences from pests, mold, mildew, and other microbial growth.
- **Water Disinfectants:** Antimicrobials are used to disinfect water in pools and spas to help kill bacteria and viruses that can cause infections or diseases.
